Monkeys are among the most underrepresented, underappreciated, and underfunded animals in the sanctuary world. Despite their intelligence, emotional depth, and social complexity, they often fall through the cracks of public awareness and charitable giving. This lack of visibility poses ongoing challenges in securing sustainable resources for nearly 200 monkeys who depend on us for specialized diets, medical care, enrichment, and permanent sanctuary. Rising costs of food, utilities, and veterinary services add additional strain, while national giving trends have declined sharply in recent years.

Yet, within these challenges lie opportunities. Jungle Friends is meeting them with creativity, transparency, and heart:
