This year has been one of growth and renewal. As we celebrate 28 years of service, we remain deeply inspired by the resilience and spirit of the monkeys who call Jungle Friends home. Each of their stories reminds us why our work matters and how compassion, commitment, and community can transform lives.

We are grateful to every supporter who has stood by us — from longtime donors and foundations to new friends who joined us this year. Because of this support, we continue to provide the best possible care for nearly 200 monkeys.

Mission and Philosophy

Our mission is to provide a permanent sanctuary for New World monkeys who have been released from laboratory research, confiscated by authorities, or surrendered by private owners. We are committed to compassionate care, education, and advocacy, ensuring every monkey lives a life of dignity, comfort, and companionship.

2024 Highlights & Accomplishments

- Continued our Shelter-In-Place Project to ensure each monkey has an inside bedroom to stay safe during severe weather.
- Successful monkey introductions, providing companions for lone monkeys.
- Strengthened partnerships with universities, other sanctuaries, and animal welfare organizations.
- Hosted over 125 Magical Monkey Experience educational tours.
- Continued to support advocacy efforts on behalf of monkeys trapped in harmful or exploitative situations.

Shelter-In-Place Project

One of our proudest achievements this year has been our ongoing Shelter-In-Place Project. Thanks to generous donations and grant funding, we were able to create new indoor accommodations connected to the monkey's outdoor habitats designed to mimic the monkeys' natural environment. These habitats include climbing structures, shaded rest areas, and enrichment zones that foster both social interaction and independence. The monkey's indoor bedrooms will allow the monkeys to shelter-in-place during dangerous storms and inclement weather.

Our future plans include the completion of our Shelter-In-Place Project and renovations to older sections of the sanctuary.

Education & Outreach

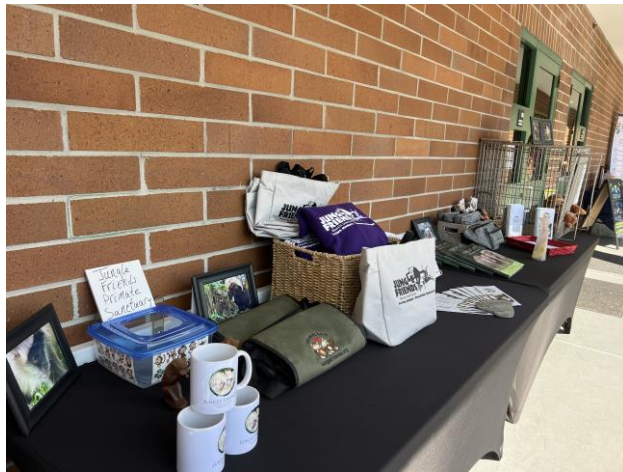

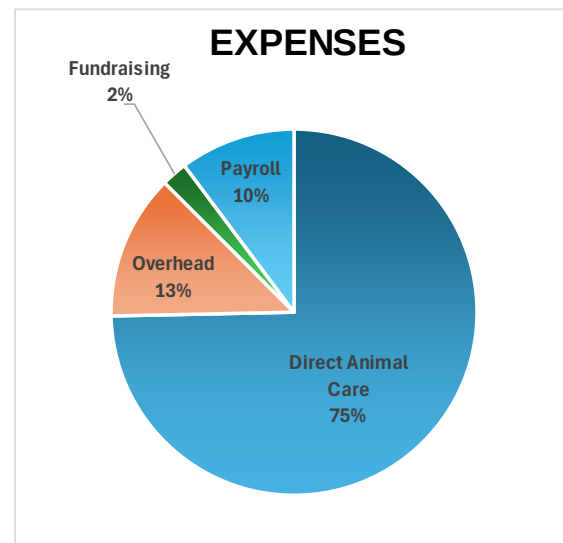
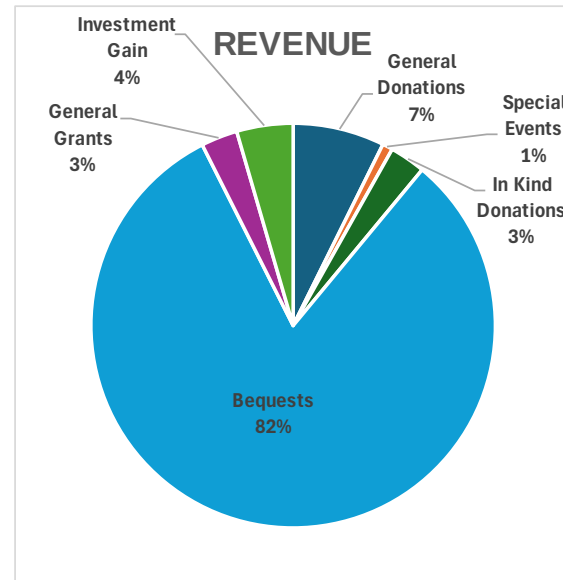
